

Trash, Recycling & Yard Waste Pick-up in Stone Ridge - Patriot Disposal

The following information below is provided to help homeowners and tenants be prepared for the transition.

Containers:

- Single Family residents will receive one 96-gallon wheeled, lidded container for trash and a 64-gallon wheeled, lidded recycling container.
- All townhouses and condos will receive one 64-gallon wheeled lidded container for trash and one 64-gallon wheeled lidded container for recycling.
- All containers from Patriot are scheduled to be delivered on the last week of October.
- Homeowners are responsible for the care and cleaning of their containers.
- There is a \$75.00 replacement charge for each 96-gallon trash container and a \$50.00 replacement fee for each 64-gallon container that is lost or stolen.

Container Storage:

- Stone Ridge Article 10, Use & Restrictions states “...trash containers shall not be permitted to remain in public view from the Community or another Lot except on days of trash collection.”
- All trash and recycle containers are to be stored in the garage or behind an approved trash enclosure, on non-trash days.

Trash Collection

- **Service days: Mondays & Thursday**
- All trash must be placed in the proper receptacle.
- Please place totes at the curb the night before or by 6 AM on pickup day.
- Please ensure that trash is bagged and inside the toter with lid closed to prevent winds from blowing trash / litter and prevent trash from flying into the street or neighboring yards.
- Containers cannot weigh more than 50 lbs., or they will not be emptied. The following items should **NOT** be placed in containers or bags at any time: *rocks, concrete, dirt, soil, sod, tree stumps, construction debris, brick, or landscaping timbers*. Collection of these items may be provided for an additional charge.
- Small furniture and mattresses can be placed at the curb with the regular trash

Recycling Collection

- **Service days: Thursday ONLY**
- Patriot Disposal’s recycling method is “single stream” which allows for the co-mingling of all recyclable materials in the recycling toter.
- All recycling must be placed in the proper receptacle.
- Your recycling toter is to be used for the sole purpose of collecting recyclables NOT for the collection of household trash
- Please remove food and liquids from recyclable bottles, cans, jugs, and jars. Rinse before recycling.
- Empty recyclables loosely into the recycling toter; Don’t bag them! Recyclables in bags will be disposed as regular trash at the recycling facility.

- Do not place plastic bags, twine, rope, string, cords, or cables in the recycling bin, or tie recyclable items with string or twine. These items jam recycling sorting equipment resulting in costly shut downs at the recycling facilities.

Allowed Recycling items

- Plastic bottles, jugs, jars
- Paper (newspaper, magazines, catalogs, paperback books, mail, office paper, gift wrap)
- Aluminum and Metal Food Containers
- Glass bottles & jars
- Flattened Carboard boxes no larger than 4' x 4'

Household Hazardous Waste

- Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) is any waste produced in the home that is potentially harmful to our health or the environment.
- Due to Loudoun County Regulations, Patriot Disposal WILL NOT collect any of the following items: *liquids of any kind, asbestos, ammunition, fuel tanks, hazardous, radioactive, infectious or medical waste, petroleum contaminated soil, dead animals, manure, dangerous acids, caustics, explosives, or other dangerous material or items too large or too heavy to be loaded safely into the collection vehicles.*
- Loudoun County Department of General Services holds Household Hazardous Waste Collection event throughout the year

Yard Waste Collection

- **Service day: MONDAYS ONLY (March 1st through December 15th)**
- Grass, leaves, twigs, branches and brush should be placed at the curb.
- Yard waste is not allowed to be set out in plastic bags per Loudoun County Ordinance.
- Grass clippings and leaves must be set out for pickup in bio-degradable paper bags or in a trash container.
- Tree limbs and brush must be tied in bundles no longer than 4 feet in length and 6 inches in diameter.
- Bundles or items that are bagged cannot exceed 50 pounds.
- Yard waste does not include stumps, rocks, dirt, sod, gravel, mulch, whole trees, or clean-up from storm damage. Collection of these items may be provided for an additional charge.

Special Pick-ups

- Residents are to contact Patriot Disposal at 703-257-7100 to arrange pickup of special and/or bulk items.
- Special items will be collected weekly for a fee.
- Special items include white goods (appliances), mid to large furniture and other large items.
- Special items that will be collected and recycled include scrap metal (grills, bicycles, swings, chairs), small electronics (computers, monitors, small TVs, small printers, VCRs, DVD/CD players, etc.), motor oil, tires and car batteries.
- Advance notice is required for the collection of all special items, **except for small furniture and mattresses which can be placed at the curb with the regular trash.**
- TVs or monitors larger than 19" will be picked up for a minimum fee of \$50.00;
- Tires will be picked up for a minimum fee of \$50.00 each.

- Carpeting will be priced for pickup on a case-by-case basis, depending on the quantity.
- Special items scheduled for pickup that are not out on the scheduled pickup day will be re-scheduled for pickup at the request of the homeowner for a \$35.00 fee which must be prepaid prior to removal.
- All fees for special pickups must be prepaid by the homeowner prior to removal.
- All items over 50 pounds will not be accepted as standard bulk service.

Christmas Trees

- Pick up days for Christmas Trees will vary each year. We will provide updates to residents on the pickup days.

INCLEMENT WEATHER:

- In the event that inclement weather prevents Patriot Disposal from providing service on a regularly scheduled collection day, service will resume on the next regularly scheduled collection day, road conditions permitting.

HOLIDAYS:

- Stone Ridge will only be impacted by Thanksgiving Day because collection day falls on one a holiday. Trash service will be picked up on Monday, December 2nd.

ROAD CONDITIONS:

- Patriot Disposal will not provide services for any homes located on roads that are deemed impassable due to construction, construction vehicles, parked cars, or other obstructions or conditions. Uncollected items will be removed on the next regularly scheduled collection day, road conditions permitting.
